Tasting Notes

This wine displays a delightful array of aromas with pear, citrus and elderflower dominating. The palate is crisp and bright with fresh nashi pear and lemon peel flavours leading to a long but gentle finish. This wine matches well with a wide range of food and is also a great aperitif. Satisfying and all too easy to drink!

Winemaker's Notes

Picked mid-season the grapes for this wine came in in pristine condition and free of disease. They were gently pressed before fermentation in stainless steel and old oak puncheons (4%). Fermentation was conducted at low temperatures (12-14C) in order to retain the wines beautiful aromatics and post fermentation the tanks were lees stirred to encourage yeast autolysis which in turn provided extra palate weight.

Viticulture Notes

From three different blocks, two in the Wairau and the third located in the Awatere Valley. All were VSP pruned and shoot thinned before a light leaf pluck, followed by a colour thin of the bunches latter in the season.
