Tasting Notes

This wine matches wonderfully lifted passion fruit notes with green grassy characters on the nose. This continues on the palate where the crisp acidity and great concentration add to the lovely length.

Winemaker's Notes

With this wine we are simply trying to express the characters that we find in the vineyards. We gently press the grapes and ferment them at cool temperatures with aromatic yeast strains. The fruit from each vineyard was fermented separately and a final selection for the finished wine was made prior to bottling.

Viticulture Notes

This wine was produced from a selection of vineyards primarily from Marlborough's Wairau Valley, with a small portion from the Awatere Valley. We also used a small portion of Semillon, which further enhances the greener characters in this wine. If required all the vines are shoot and bunch tinned to moderate the crop levels and produce greater aromatics and concentrated flavours.
